Requests for Preparation in Normal Times

Recommendation of stockpiling at home and the workplace

Also effective during disasters!

Plan to buy and store items slightly more than usual.
Consume older items by replacing them with new items.

Request for Confirmation to Prepare for Infectious Disease Crisis

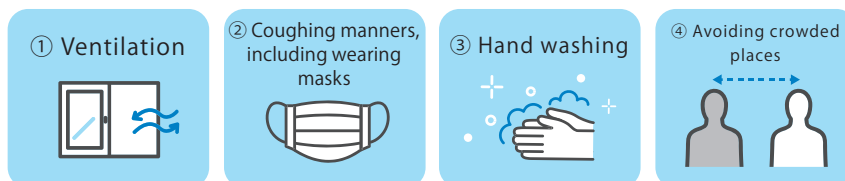
Under the infectious disease crisis, the following cooperation may be requested, so please review these measures in normal times.

Points in daily life

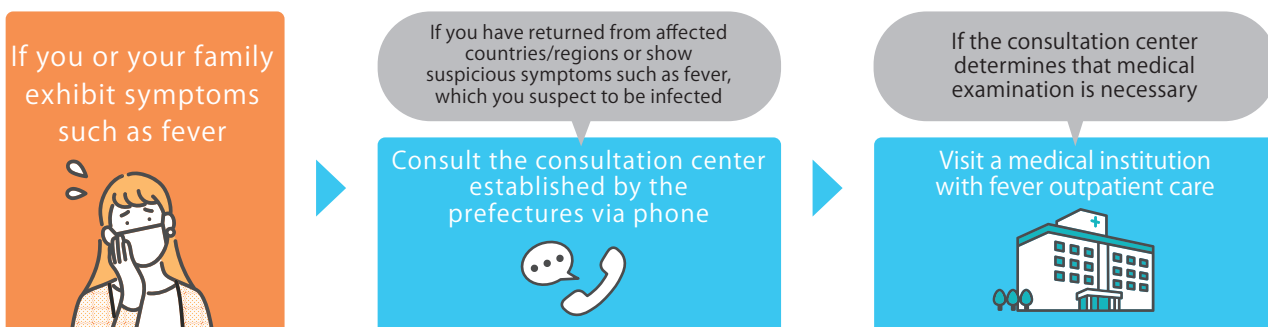
- **Basic infectious disease measures**
(ventilation, coughing manners such as wearing masks, hand washing, avoiding crowded places, etc.)
- Efforts such as staggered working hours, teleworking, and online meetings.

Points for Visiting Hospitals



(Note) Once vaccines or treatments are widely available, the system will transition from connecting patients to fever outpatient care via consultation centers to allowing symptomatic patients to directly visit fever outpatient care.

Anticipated Measures of Novel Influenza, etc.

To prevent the domestic spread of highly infectious new diseases, the following measures may be implemented as necessary.

- **Under intensive measures for prevention of spread of infection, etc.** changes business hours, recommendations for employees to undergo testing, prohibition of entry for those with fever, disseminating infectious disease measures and prohibition for those who disobey the measures.
- **Based on declaration of a state of emergency,** requests for refraining from going out, suspending the use of facilities, limitations or cancellations of events.

| System Development | ■ Building a system that provides infectious disease medical care (hospitalization, fever outpatient care, etc.) by concluding medical service agreements between prefectures and medical institutions. |
| | ■ Developing a testing system and securing equipment and materials in normal times to enable testing to begin promptly after outbreaks. |
| | ■ Promoting research and development of vaccines and therapeutic agents for priority infectious disease such as pandemic influenza in normal times strengthen foundations of research and development. |
| Stockpiling | ■ Establishing systems that ensure the sufficient distribution of infectious disease control supplies such as pharmaceuticals, medical devices, personal protective equipment, etc., to medical facilities and other necessary institutions. |
