

Strengthen the leadership function led by the Cabinet Agency for Infectious Diseases Crisis Management

The Cabinet Act was amended to establish the Cabinet Agency for Infectious Diseases Crisis Management in the Cabinet Secretariat to strengthen the leadership response to infectious disease crises and establish a system that can respond promptly and appropriately. (Date of establishment: September 1, 2023)

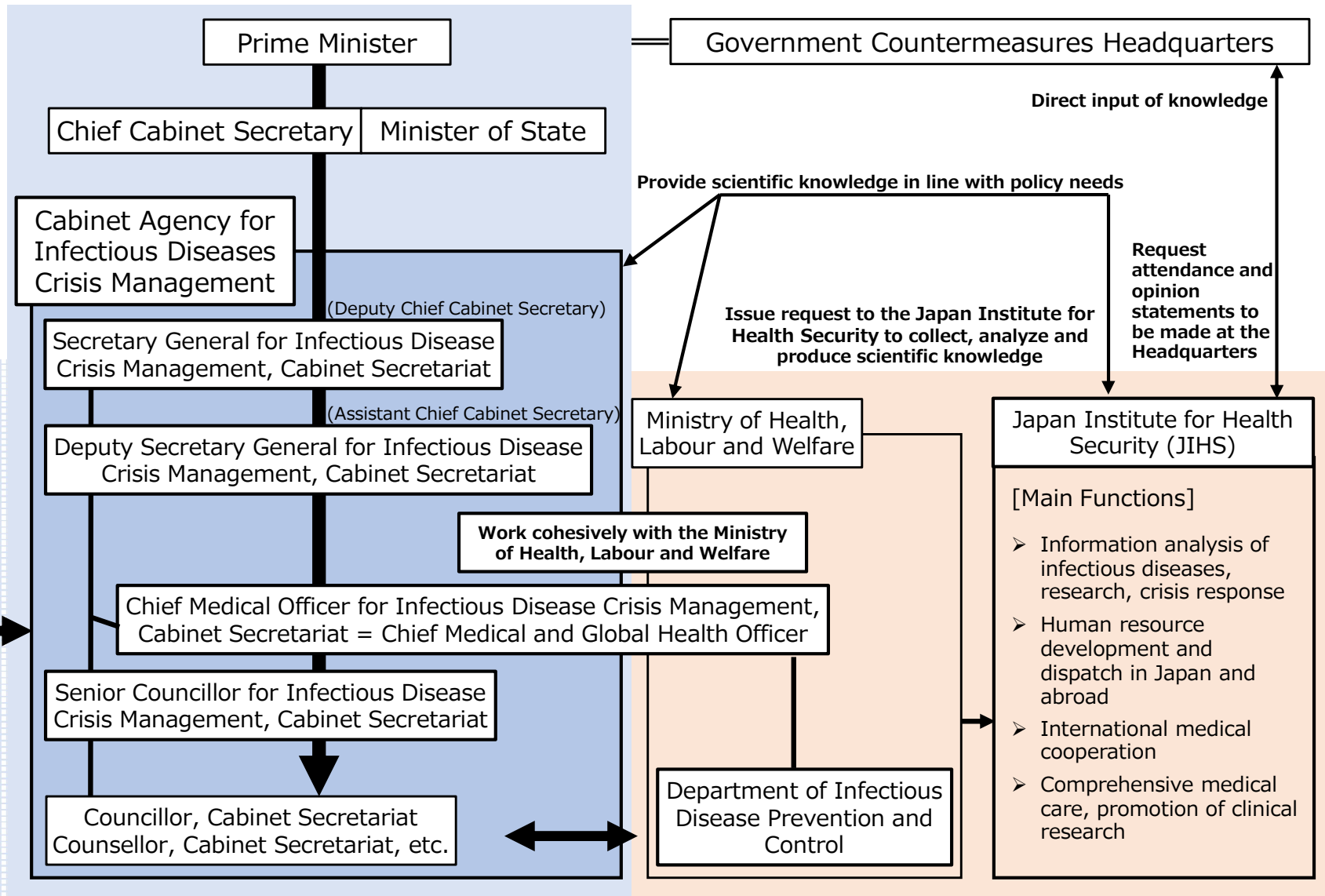
★The Cabinet Agency for Infectious Diseases Crisis Management directly assists the Prime Minister and the Chief Cabinet Secretary, and has centralized control over the planning and formulating policies for responding to infectious diseases and the overall coordination of relevant ministries.

Deputy Chief Cabinet Secretary for Crisis Management

★Crisis management related to infectious diseases is centrally controlled and implemented by the Cabinet Agency for Infectious Diseases Crisis Management.

*Deputy Chief Cabinet Secretary for Crisis Management works with the Cabinet Agency for Infectious Diseases Crisis Management on crisis management related to infectious diseases, as ordered on an ad hoc basis.

★Reception and implementation of expert knowledge from the Department of Infectious Disease Prevention and Control and the JIHS, using the Chief Medical and Global Health Officer as a focal point for coordination amongst various ministries and entities.
